- Small, post-like device that is surgically placed into the jaw bone to replace a missing tooth root
- Bone grows and bonds to the implant surface
- Implants transmit chewing forces to the jaw bone, helping to maintain bone & facial structure
- Your customized prosthesis is created and attached to the implant – giving you a new smile

Straumann full-arch solutions replace missing teeth in the upper or lower jaw, with a full-arch bridge supported by 4 – 6 dental implants. The implants provide secure and lasting support for the bridge and your new teeth. Depending on your situation, your dentist may even be able to place a temporary bridge on the day of your surgery or soon after. There are two types of solutions available:

- **Fixed, or non-removable, dentures** are attached to dental implants, and are removed for cleaning and maintenance by your dentist
- **Removable dentures** are attached to dental implants, but are removed by you daily for cleaning

Implant-supported dentures can restore a quality of life you may have lost with missing teeth. They offer many important benefits

- Feel and look like natural teeth
- Help prevent and minimize bone loss
- Help preserve surrounding healthy teeth & facial structure
- Improve appearance and oral function
- Eliminate pressure spots and sores caused by traditional dentures

The Procedure.

This is the procedure we will follow for your new implant-retained dentures.

Examination and planning

Your expectations and health conditions are clarified. They are the basis for the treatment plan that suits you most.

Surgery and temporization

The implants are placed and an impression is taken. According to your individual needs, your doctor may choose to create a temporary denture immediately.

Impression-taking and final restoration

After healing, an impression is made. The final restoration will be fabricated and secured to the healed implants in your mouth.

Creating your new smile

We now begin the process of creating your final restoration. You will continue to wear your temporary during this restorative phase. Since this restoration is being customized, your dentist will detail the next steps required for your new smile.

Every surgical procedure carries potential risks. You should always consult with a dental professional prior to treatment. Potential risk factors may vary depending on medical or other conditions of each patient.
