PRESENTING TREATMENT OPTIONS VS. A TREATMENT PLAN TO IMPROVE CASE ACCEPTANCE

In this module, Dr. Sear describes his three steps for effective case presentation. Instead of beginning with a treatment plan and working backward, you will learn to first convey findings, then review potential consequences and finish by co-creating multiple treatment options with the patient.

- Understand one option of how to address fees in the presentation process


